

Chandler Baptist Church Youth Pastor Job Description

Part-time: 12-15 hours weekly
Compensation: \$14,000 annually

JOB SUMMARY

The Youth Pastor will lead and organize an effective youth ministry, implementing fellowship, worship, Biblical teaching, discipleship, and evangelism. Most importantly, he/she should demonstrate a hunger for more of God and possess a passion to lead the youth of our church and community into that same hunger. The overall objective of the Youth Pastor is to help make Christ like disciples of our youth, and to train and mobilize them to make Christ like disciples.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Teach weekly lesson or Bible study (possibly two- traditionally Wednesday and Sunday evening).
2. Organize Sunday School and be present during Sunday worship.
3. Develop and equip adult leaders (ex- Sunday School teachers).
4. Regular communication with students and parents.
5. One monthly event (this could include retreats, but often will be a fun fellowship activity)
6. Organize and attend a summer camp, a mission trip, or similar event. (Separate compensation)
7. Develop relationships with CBC students outside of church through text/social communication, but also in person. (Chandler will provide meal and mileage to offset any expenses).
8. Provide overall theological direction in accordance with the beliefs of CBC.
9. Model strong and relational Christian leadership to the youth of the church.
10. Responsible for the preparation and supervision of the Youth Ministry Budget.
11. Demonstrate adequate planning and preparation to Senior Pastor for all programs and activities so that each event will be effective in accomplishing its stated purpose.
12. Regular meetings with Senior Pastor.
